Handylift Swinger



Small, light, but still powerful

The super small Handylift Swinger is the ideal quick, portable solution if lifting sewer covers with two keyholes. It will fit in almost any car boot and as it weighs just 16kg even the most petite engineer can use it. Despite its small size and light weight it is most certainly no weakling. It has a safe working load of 1 tonne, giving it enough power to tackle stuck covers.



The Handylift Swinger comes complete with a pair of lifting keys for sewer covers, and different sizes are available if you have covers with various sizes of keyhole. One big advantage of the Swinger lifters is that they can lift split 'double triangle' covers without the need for accessories. The lifter will lock both halves together to lift the cover as one, as seen in the main photo above.

Handylift Swinger XL for bigger covers

The standard model is capable of lifting covers up to 650 x 650mm. For covers larger than this, we also stock the Handylift Swinger XL. This unit is a physically larger version of the standard model, and can tackle covers up to 850 x 850mm.

A useful accessory for both models is a PVC carry bag. This is a lightweight but robust transport method that protects the lifter and will help ensure the keys don't get lost. See our Handylift price list for details.
